## **CONCERT RELATED:**

### **Coordinated Spirit of the Music wine, food & raffle items**

Organizations that assisted include: Portofinos, Briar Leaf, Bernacchi's, Cookery, Friends of the Symphony donated cookies, Morris's and Rodger's loaned the quilts and Kellene and Lee donated baskets and coordinated other food items.

There have been several meetings to coordinate logistics of the **April concert**. Volunteers from the theater groups in the area have been rehearsing, writing and directing the program, months of preparation have happened before the orchestra begins rehearsals.

## **OTHER:**

**Friends of the Symphony Luncheon was held March 10.** It was the first luncheon in 2009 due to cancelling January due to weather conditions. Hoosier Star report was give by Sheryl Edwards and Executive Director reported on April Concert, while also stressing the importance of community support of the orchestra events and challenged Friends to raise money for the orchestra in some way. Nanda Danitschek sang with Sue Rosselli accompany to promote April Pops.

### **Hired Jim Snyder - Operation Manager with approval of Board President and Music Director/Conductor**

He was able to schedule to work on set up for the March concert and will be fully ready to work on the April Pops concert. He has been working for many months as a volunteer that is the Stage Director for the singers in the April Pops concert as well.

### **May 5 is LCSO day at Briar Leaf Golf Club**

They and we will promote the day through our communications and mostly e-blasts. It is not an outing, but a golf day where the entire cart fees \$15.00 per golfer is donated back to the orchestra. In the afternoon, Briar Leaf will offer free beverages from the cart. We may promote the season with flyers, and a presence with the beverage cart.

### **Other Fund Raising**

CASA approached us to see about combining efforts for a Fall Event at the Civic. It would be a 50/50 commitment and 50/50 split of proceeds. This event would replace our Fall Gala and their Fall Wine Tasting. The goal is to appeal to 500 people at the Civic in a quality live auction, light food and entertaining event. October 16, 6:00-9:00pm at the LP Civic.

The Art Barn would like us to partner with them at a Fashion Show at Strongbows in Valpo. Currently we are working on communication on details of expectations so good decisions may be made regarding our affiliation. Keeping in mind that we are budgeted for one major fundraiser next season.

### **Other Community Connections**

Community Concert Association would like to partner in some way. We discussed offering a combined ticket that would cover their season and ours. However, it seems that most ways that this could occur would be confusing to our patrons in any advertising efforts. They are bringing a Flutist for a concert and asked if we could use our education department to put together some classes or school features. It does not appear to be beneficial to us at this time.
